

N1 N	otes for the Solo Pilot and DLGC Instructor
1	Pilot will complete section P2
2	Instructor to allocate at A1 a DLGC equivalent card colour, based on Pilot Information at P2. Solo flying will be restricted to launches North/South in benign conditions only. Extra tests are specified for solo flying in more challenging conditions and launch directions at F3
3	Instructor to record at A2 the glider types the pilot is approved to fly and at A3 any endorsements allowed. (E.g. Instructing, P1 2 seater)
4	Instructor can specify at F2 & F3 which tests must be flown or can be waived before solo flight-based on review of the log book (F1) and discussion with the pilot about the information at P2.
5	Pilot must complete the test flying specified in F2 before solo flight, unless waived.
6	Pilot must seek the advice of an Instructor before solo flight if the prevailing conditions are as specified in F3.
7	Pilot who is DLGC member to satisfy additional requirements at F4. This section can be ignored by visitors
8	Pilot should note the restrictions, permissions and requirements of card colours in the Information Section I 1.
9	Pilot must produce this card with log book when a briefing is required or test completed.
10	Pilot should ask for an Instructor briefing If wave conditions are reported

I1 The	I1 The following standards and requirements apply			
All Cards	 No one will be launched without an Approved Launch Marshall present at the launch point. Flying will be subject to specified currency, annual checks and weather conditions/limits. May only fly glider types for which approved (except Green card). Must have a pre-flight briefing from an Instructor until LAPL(S) or SPL obtained. 			
White	 On daily check unless signed off. May fly only within gliding range of the site. May launch to North or South only, with a maximum flight time of 45 minutes. Max 90° X-wind 5kts (until X-wind sign off). 			
Red	 May only fly within gliding range of the Club. May launch to West when qualified and satisfactory check flight or approval on the day. May not soar below circuit height of the day or above cloud base 			
Yellow	 Must obtain pre-flight briefing unless LAPL(S) or SPL obtained Must get XC briefing from qualified instructor before any XC until Sliver badge and licence obtained. 			
Green	 Self briefing May fly in any safe conditions subject to specified currency, and annual checks 			

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
